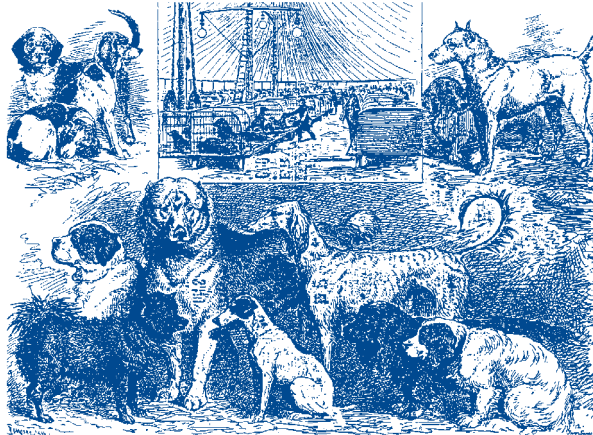

## **Kennel Club Breeders' Competition 2010**

The Breeders' Competition offers the following Awards:

**Best Breeder in Breed**

**Best Breeder in AVNSC Classes**

**Best Breeder in Group 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th**

**Grand Final at DFS Crufts 2011**

The following requirements apply to entries for these awards:

1. Breeders wishing to enter the competition should first purchase a Breeders Competition Record Book from the Kennel Club or from the show secretary.
2. The Breeder enters for the award in his/her name and is responsible for arranging which exhibits form their breeder group, or team
3. The Breeder must complete the Record Book accurately with all necessary details before presenting it to the show organisers.
4. The Breeder is responsible for obtaining the necessary authority to compete from the show organisers (or designated official such as the Ring Steward) to compete for the award.
5. The Breeder's team must comprise four exhibits of the same breed, all of which must be entered in a class at the show.
6. A Breeder may enter more than one team per show.
7. All dogs must have the same registered breeder.
8. The 'beaten dog' rule will NOT apply.
9. Best Breeder in Breed and Best Breeder in AVNSC Classes goes through to a Best Breeder in Group award.
10. Breeders acquire points in competition over a calendar year as follows:

Breed win	1 point
Win in AVNSC Classes	1 point
Fourth in Group	1 point
Third in Group	2 points
Second in Group	3 points
First in Group	4 points

The thirty Breeders who have amassed the highest number of points over a calendar year will qualify for the DFS Crufts Final in the following year. At the end of the competition year in question, Breeders should forward their record books to the Canine Activities Department at the Kennel Club which will advise whether they have qualified for the DFS Crufts Final.

## EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

Southern Counties Canine Association Championship Show is a THREE DAY SHOW

Not separately classified Exhibitors may only enter on the day of their Group

**Breed Judging commences at 10.00 am promptly unless notified otherwise on passes and/or in the Dog Press (N.B. Veteran Stakes Classes begin at 9.30 am)**

If, in the event of a change of judge or other emergency, the order of judging is changed this will also be announced in the Dog Press where time allows. While we do everything possible to help the exhibitor it is the exhibitors' responsibility to be in time for their classes.

### **Order of Stakes Classes:**

**Main Ring** — Veteran at 9.30 am followed by Champion at approx. 10.30 am followed by Pup of the Year, Y.K.C., Charity, Members' and Reserve CC.

**Petplan Ring** — **Day 1:** A.V.N.S.C. Gundog at 10.00 am followed by Petplan Junior Stakes at 1.00 pm followed by A.V.N.S.C. Utility, A.V. Rare Breeds and A.V. Imported Register. **Day 2:** A.V.N.S.C. Hound at 10.00 am followed by A.V.N.S.C. Toy followed by Petplan Junior Stakes at 1.00 pm followed by A.V.N.S.C. Terrier, A.V. Rare Breeds and A.V. Imported Register. **Day 3:** A.V.N.S.C. Pastoral at 10.00 am followed by Petplan Junior Stakes at 1.00 pm followed by A.V.N.S.C. Working, A.V. Rare Breeds and A.V. Imported Register.

**Junior and Adult Handling Classes will follow the Imported Register Classes each day**

You will receive a detailed map with your pass which gives you information on your benching area, judging ring and wet weather judging area.

# RULES and REGULATIONS

**Vicious dogs are not eligible and must not be brought to the Show**

**Exhibitors are held responsible for any damage done by their dog during the exhibition.**

*The Show will be held under Kennel Club Rules and Show Regulations*

1. On the days of the Show, dogs will be received from 7.00 am. All exhibits must be accompanied. The exhibition will be open to the public from 9.00 am.
2. Dogs will be received until 12.00 noon after which no dogs may be received except under exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
3. Judging will commence at 10.00 am except for those dogs marked in the schedule or notified through the dog press, and except for the Veteran Stakes, which will commence at 9.30 am.
4. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed at which time dogs must be removed.
5. Exhibits may be removed at 11.00 a.m. They may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Practitioner or of the Show Management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to the Kennel Club..
6. The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of tenting and benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the Show management.
7. The entry fee for EACH DOG for the first class is £22.00 and £3.00 for subsequent classes for that dog. The entry fee for a breed for which CCs are not on offer AT THIS SHOW is £12.50 for the first class and Not For Competition is also £12.50. Each exhibitor will receive one free pass per dog entered. No fees will be returned on the grounds of non-receipt of passes etc. Entry fees will not be refunded once an entry is made, the entrance fee of a dog entered but not sent to the show will be forfeited. There will be no spectator admission fee. A car park pass will be sent to every exhibitor. Cheques and postal orders should be crossed and made payable to SCCA. Please write the Breed and name and address on the back of cheques. A £10.00 fee will be charged on any cheques which have to be re-presented.
8. Prize money is on offer in the Stakes Classes only (see classification for amounts).
9. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries on reasonable grounds. The Committee is also empowered to exclude any dog which is not in a fit state for exhibition from disease, vice, natural or other causes and if such exclusion takes place the entrance fee will be forfeited. Rule F (1) (15).
10. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition, i.e. born on or after **5th December 2009**.
11. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
12. There is **NO** competition for Best Puppy in Show.
13. **Best in Show** The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same Show.
  - a. *Shows Judged on the Group System:* (Definition: Shows judged on the Group System includes classes for breeds within more than one Group, as defined in Kennel Club Regulation B(A); and requires a judge to declare a Best of each Group after which the exhibits so declared will compete for the award of Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show.)
    - 1) *Best of Breed:* Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed must be declared from those exhibits which have received an award. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be selected from which the Best of Breed must be declared from those exhibits which have received an award.
    - 2) *Best of Group:* Best of Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:-
      - a) The Best of Breed winners in each group provided that they are unbeaten winning dogs.
      - b) The best unbeaten winning dog from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group or on each day.
    - 3) *Best in Show:* Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners provided they are unbeaten. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection of Best in Show.
  - b. *Withdrawal from other Competition:* Dogs which become eligible for Best of Group and Best in Show maybe withdrawn from all other competition other than breed classes and Best of Breed prior to the competition for Best of Group or Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best of Group or Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Dogs may be withdrawn from Any Variety Classes when judged before Breed Classes.
  - c. *Proviso:* For the purposes of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to a single breed, will not be considered to be beaten dogs.
14. Exhibits will not be admitted to Group or Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
15. No modifications will be made to this Schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.

16. All dogs resident outside of the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
17. **Dogs in Cars on Hot Days.** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
  - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
  - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
  - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
  - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
  - Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
  - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare. **WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.** Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.

18. Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.
19. All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (B) - Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
20. All rules and regulations, or definitions or instructions of the nature of rules and regulations, printed for convenience in other parts of this schedule shall be deemed to be regulations of the Committee, and shall have the same effect as if they formed part of these Regulations.

An announcement prior to the date of closing of entries in "Our Dogs" or the "Dog World" of any alteration or addition made in the schedule or in these regulations, shall be deemed to be sufficient notice thereof.

Every exhibitor making an entry or entries at or for this show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by the Kennel Club Rules and Show Regulations and by these regulations, and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.

21. All entries must be made on or before **Tuesday, 20th April 2010 (Postmark)** upon forms enclosed for that purpose. The entry fees must be forwarded to the Secretary with the completed entry form on or before **Tuesday, 20th April 2010 (Postmark)** or entry will not be accepted. No acknowledgement will be sent unless a stamped addressed postcard is sent with entries. **On-line entries** can be made up until midnight on **Tuesday, 27th April 2010 at [www.fossedata.co.uk](http://www.fossedata.co.uk)**.
22. The Committee is empowered to exclude or remove any dog which, in the opinion of the Show Management and/or the Veterinary Surgeon is not in a fit state for exhibition owing to disease, vice or any other cause. If such exclusion takes place either before or after the dog is judged, the entrance fee will be forfeited.
23. Exhibitors will be responsible for their dogs being in time for judging. No dog may be removed from its bench except for the purpose of being prepared for exhibition, judged, exercised or by order of the Veterinary Surgeon or the Show Committee. After being prepared for exhibition the dog must be replaced on its bench. **No dog shall be absent from its bench for the purpose of exercise for longer than 30 minutes.**
24. Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling their engagement, the Executive Committee reserve to themselves the right of appointing other judges to fulfill their duties. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw from competition but no entry fees can be refunded. (Vide Kennel Club Show Regulation).
25. The judges will be instructed and empowered to withhold the prize or prizes in any class if, in their opinion, the dog or dogs exhibited do not possess sufficient merit. Judges are not empowered to give prizes beyond those offered in the Schedule. Any such award shall not have any value or count as a win except if the consent of the Secretary be first obtained in writing. (Vide Kennel Club Show Regulation).
26. Any owner, competitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s) at any Kennel Club licensed show within the licensed venue and within the environs of that event including car and caravan parks and approaches. Adequate receptacles for the disposal of such fouling will be provided.
27. All gangways between benches must be kept clear at all times and free from obstructions such as grooming tables, etc. Any obstructions will be removed by authorised officials (Vide Kennel Club Show Regulation). Special places will be provided for the cleaning, preparation and exercising of exhibits and no other place on the showground must be used for such purposes.

28. **Veterinary Examination.** A Veterinary Surgeon will be in attendance throughout the Show.
29. **Safety Officer.** A Safety Officer will be in attendance throughout the show. Exhibitors and spectators are reminded that just as Southern Counties Canine Association has a responsibility to ensure the health and safety of all those attending their event, all those present have a duty and responsibility for their own safety. They are therefore expected to take the greatest care to avoid guy ropes, uneven surfaces and other hazards which are inevitable and integral elements of a dog show. Those bringing and using portable items of equipment such as folding chairs, trolleys, cages and grooming tables also have a responsibility to ensure that their tools, equipment and collapsible furniture is used and erected safely and does not constitute a hazard to others. Exhibitors are also reminded that they should wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the prevailing conditions on the site. Exhibitors show at their own risk if conditions are not ideal.
30. Committee members of SCCA will patrol benching and grooming areas throughout the show.
31. The Committee will not be responsible for the loss, detention of, or damage to any dog, person or property whether arising from accident, or any other cause whatever, or from any act or omission of itself, its officers, agents, servants or others or the damage done by the exhibitor to any person or property.
32. Parents will be held responsible for any damage to property or equipment caused by their children within the environs of the Show.
33. A dog may be disqualified by the General Committee from any award, whether an objection has been lodged or not, if proved amongst other things to have been: a) registered or recorded as having been bred by the scheduled Judge. This shall not apply to a Judge appointed in an emergency; b) exhibited without payment of appropriate entry fees.
34. Every exhibitor shall ensure that whilst the dog is being exhibited, its handler shall display the correct ring number.

## **REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F (Annex B)**

1. These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A 42.
  - a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat.
  - b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A 42.
2.
  - a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the Show.
  - b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:
  - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
  - (b) The removal of dew claws of any breed.
  - (c) Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.

Nor must anything be done calculated in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
4. The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate) to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

# DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

The word 'dog' includes both sexes

## **PUPPIES UNDER SIX CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW ARE NOT ELIGIBLE**

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club. Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class, i.e. **Tuesday, 13th April 2010.**

Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering for Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A First Prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value. A dog is not eligible for entry in Variety Classes (excluding AVNSC Classes) unless also entered and subsequently exhibited in a Breed class where such a class is provided for which it is eligible. Exemptions from this Regulation:-

- (1) A puppy, unless a class for dogs under twelve months of age for which it is eligible is provided for the breed.
- (2) A dog in Any Variety Veteran Class.
- (3) A dog in Any Variety Champion Class.
- (4) As provided in Kennel Club Definitions of Classes.
- (5) A dog in Y.K.C. Stakes Classes.
- (6) A dog which is withdrawn from exhibition in breed classes as a result of the appointment of an emergency judge.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:

- (1) *Withdrawal*  
The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) and 20.
- (2) *Transfer*
  - a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted, to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
  - b) If an exhibit is entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or twenty four calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling class to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
  - c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
  - d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

**MINOR PUPPY** For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show (i.e. born between 4th September 2009 and 4th December 2009 inclusive).

**PUPPY** For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show (i.e. born between 4th June 2009 and 4th December 2009 inclusive).

**JUNIOR** For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show (i.e. born between 4th December 2008 and 4th December 2009 inclusive).

**YEARLING** For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four months of age on the first day of the Show (i.e. born between 4th June 2008 and 4th June 2009 inclusive).

**MAIDEN** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or a First Prize at an Open or Championship show (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

**NOVICE** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First Prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

**GRADUATE** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or four or more First prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**POST GRADUATE** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**LIMIT** For dogs which have not become show Champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit and Open classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**OPEN** For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

**VETERAN** For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

**VETERAN STAKES** For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the day of the Show.

**EUKANUBA CHAMPION STAKES** For dogs which have been confirmed a Champion or a Show Champion, except that a dog will not be eligible for entry if it has already won a similar class for the same event during 2009.

**PURINA PRO PLAN/DOG WORLD PUPPY STAKES** Open to all puppies of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Dogs which have already qualified for the 2009 Purina Pro Plan/Dog World Pup of the Year final are not eligible to compete.

**PETPLAN JUNIOR STAKES** For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show (i.e. born between 4th December 2008 and 4th December 2009 inclusive). Dogs which have already qualified for the 2010 Petplan Junior Stakes final are not eligible to compete.

**Y.K.C. MEMBERS STAKES** All pedigree dogs are eligible to take part provided the dog is registered on the Kennel Club Breed Register. The dog must be registered either a) solely or jointly in the member's name or b) in the name of a member of the family and under these circumstances the dog must be resident at the YKC member's address. No substitute handlers are permitted - the dog must be handled by the YKC member. Members are not permitted to allow another individual to show their dog on their behalf if they are not able to attend the class. Members must be aged 6 - 24 years (for members 6 years and up to, but not including 25th birthday). **DFS Crufts 2011 Qualification Procedure:** The first placed member only in each dog group at the qualifying show will qualify for DFS Crufts. A rosette and prize money is awarded. If the first placed member has already qualified, the DFS Crufts qualification will roll down to the next member (down to third place only).

**S.C.C.A. OPEN CHARITY STAKES** For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show. All the entry fees from this class will go to Southern Counties' designated charity for the year. The Association will match whatever figure is raised from the class so the income for the charity is doubled. The Charity for 2010 is the Petplan Charitable Trust.

**S.C.C.A. MEMBERS' STAKES** Open to Members' dogs. Membership for 2010 must be paid by close of entries at the latest.

**S.C.C.A. RESERVE CC STAKES** Open to dogs which have won one or more Reserve CCs but have not won a CC before 13th April 2010.

**RARE BREEDS** Confined to those breeds not granted Challenge Certificates in the current year, with the exception of those breeds whose registration is confined to the Imported Register.

**IMPORTED REGISTER** For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by the Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class only, and are ineligible for any other competition whatsoever.

**ANY VARIETY NOT SEPARATELY CLASSIFIED** For breeds of dog for which no separate breed classes are scheduled.

**J.H.A. HANDLING** Open to junior handlers aged 6 - 11 years and 12 - 16 years.

**ADULT HANDLING** Open to handlers aged over 16 years.

**KENNEL CLUB BREEDERS' COMPETITION** Entries are to be made on the day and will be taken in the Secretary's office until 12.00 noon each day. See inside front cover for further details.

#### **ADVISORY NOTICE**

**NOT FOR COMPETITION** Societies may at their discretion, accept Not for Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed.
