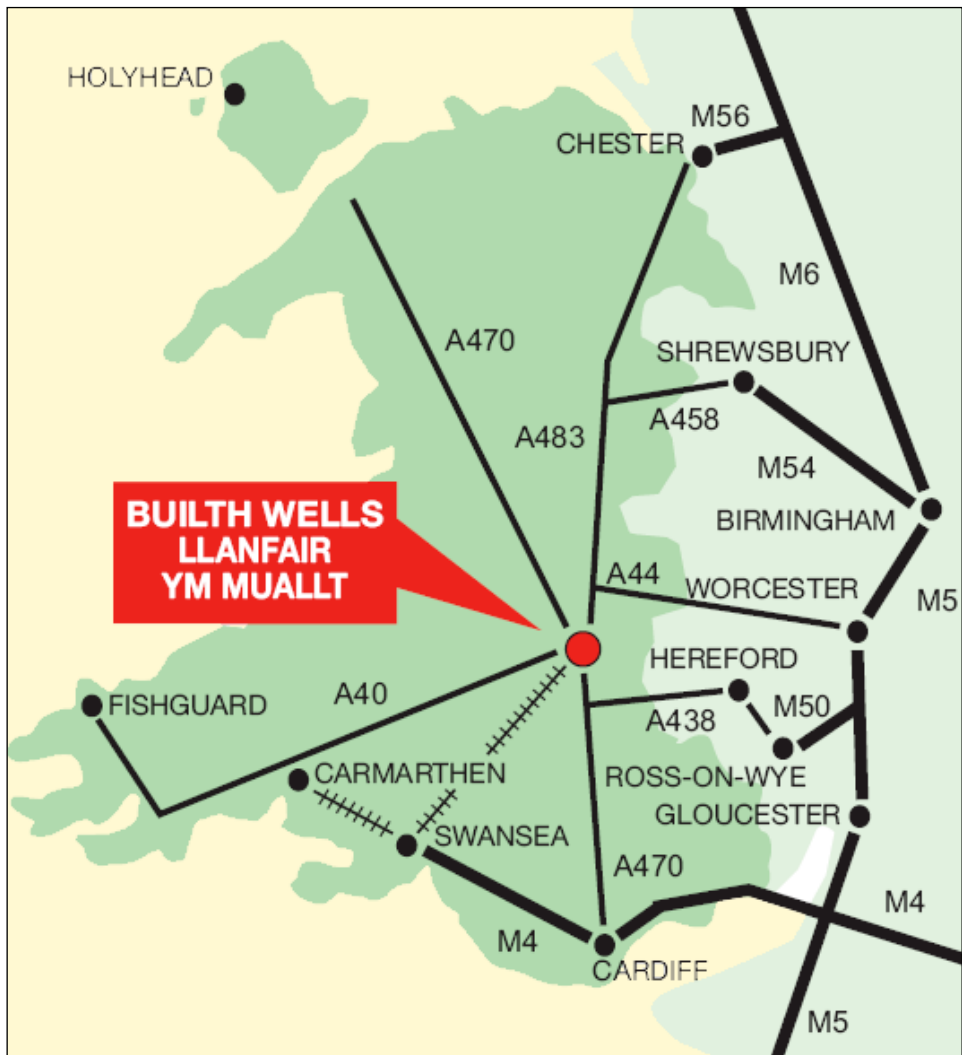

• RULES AND REGULATIONS •

1. The Show will open at 7.30 am.
2. Dogs will be received until 11.30 am and after which no dogs may be received except under exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management.
3. Judging will commence at 9.30 am.
4. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed at which time dogs must be removed.
5. Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon, Veterinary Practitioner or of the Show Management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to the Kennel Club.
6. The entry fee for each dog is £24.00 for the first entry for breeds with CCs - £14.00 for breeds without CCs, AVNSC, Imported Register - £14.00 for Veteran & Champion Stakes if 1st entry - £3.00 for YKC, Puppy, Junior, Good Citizen Dog Scheme and RCC/Reserve Best of Sex Stakes - £12.00 for Not For Competition per dog - £3.00 each subsequent entry with same dog. Catalogues: £4.00 pre-paid with entries, £5.00 on the day. Car Parking: £3.00 pre-paid with entries, £5.00 on the day. Caravans from noon on Friday, 20th April until noon on Sunday, 22nd April - £20.00. The Royal Welsh Agricultural Society will charge a separate fee for caravans at the ground before or after the stated period.
7. Prize Money: Puppy, Junior, Champion & RCC/Reserve Best of Sex Stakes: 1st £5.00; 2nd £3.00; 3rd £2.00. KC Good Citizen Dog Scheme Stakes: 1st £50.00; 2nd £25.00; 3rd £10.00; 4th £5.00.
8. The committee reserves the right to refuse entries.
9. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
10. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
11. The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of tenting and benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.
12. **Best Puppy in Show** Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same show. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed, Best of Group or Best in Show is a puppy it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly, if the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best in Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group or Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed and Best in Show respectively.
 - a. *Championship Shows Judged on the Group System* (Definition: Shows judged on Group System - Refer to Regulation 27.b.)
 - 1) *Best Puppy in Breed*: A Best Puppy must be declared in each breed from puppies entered in the Breed Classes.
 - 2) *Best Puppy in Group*: Best Puppy in Group and subsequent Puppy Group placings must be selected from:-
 - a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed provided that they are unbeaten by any other puppy.
 - b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group or on each day provided it is unbeaten by any other puppy.
 - b. *Withdrawal from Competition*: Puppies which become eligible for Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition, other than breed classes and Best Puppy in Breed, prior to the competition for Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show as appropriate, in order to remain unbeaten. A puppy beaten in competition for Best Puppy in Group or Best Puppy in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dog declared Best Puppy in Show, however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Puppies may be withdrawn from Any Variety Classes when judged before Breed Classes.
 - c. *Proviso*: For the purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
12. **Best in Show** The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same Show.

Definition of a High Profile Breed. A breed from time to time designated by the General Committee as requiring particular monitoring by reason of visible condition(s) which may cause health or welfare concerns. The list of designated High Profile Breeds is kept under regular review and is published from time to time in the Kennel Gazette.

 - a. *Shows Judged on the Group System* (Definition: Shows judged on the Group System as defined in Kennel Club Regulation B(A); and requires a judge to declare a Best of each Group after which the exhibits so declared will compete for the award of Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show.)
 - 1) *Best of Breed*: Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared but only from those dogs which have received an a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be must be declared.

NOTE: The Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified award relevant to a High Profile Breed will not be confirmed until the dog has passed an examination by the General and Group Championship Show Veterinary Surgeon.

2) *Best of Group*: Best of Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:-

- a) The Best of Breed winners in each group provided that they are unbeaten winning dogs.
- b) The best unbeaten winning dog from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group or on each day.

NOTE: The dog declared Best of Breed/Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified from a breed designated by the Kennel Club as a High Profile Breed is not eligible to compete in the Group competition unless it has passed an examination by the Show's Veterinary Surgeon. If the dog fails to pass the examination it is ineligible to compete in the relevant Group.

3) *Best in Show*: Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners provided they are unbeaten. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection of Best in Show.

b. *Withdrawal from other Competition*: Dogs which become eligible for Best of Group and Best in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition other than breed classes and Best of Breed prior to the competition for Best of Group or Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best of Group or Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Dogs may be withdrawn from Any Variety Classes when judged before Breed Classes.

c. *Proviso*: For the purposes of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to a single breed, will not be considered to be beaten dogs.

14. Exhibits will not be admitted to Group or Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.

15. No modification will be made to this Schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.

16. All dogs resident outside of the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.

17. **Dogs in Cars on Hot Days**. Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.

- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
- If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
- The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
- When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
- Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
- Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare. **WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.** Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.

18. Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered.

19. All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F Annex B - Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.

20. All dogs must be brought with a suitable chain and collar so that the dogs may be properly fastened on the benching. No dog shall be absent from its bench for the purpose of being exercised at any time for longer than 15 minutes, except that at Shows where more than one breed of dog is scheduled dogs may be absent from their benches and be present at the ringside when their breed is being judged.

21. Each exhibit must be benching on the numbered bench allocated to it in the Catalogue. No partitions should be removed from the benching.

22. Should any Judge be prevented from fulfilling his or her engagement the Committee reserves the right to appoint a substitute. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw their dogs from competition under such circumstances, but no entrance fee will be returned.

23. A special place will be provided for the cleaning and preparation of dogs, and no exhibitor will be permitted to clean or prepare dogs in any other place within the precincts of the Show. Any owner, competitor, handler or

other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s) at any Kennel Club licensed show within the licensed venue and within the environs of that event including car and caravan parks and approaches.

24. No animal other than exhibits will be allowed within the precincts of the Show.
 25. No acknowledgement of receipt of entries will be sent unless a stamped, addressed postcard is enclosed with the entries. Exhibitors' passes will be sent as soon as possible but if any exhibitor has not received his or her pass 5 days before the Show, the Secretary must be notified.
 26. All Rules and Regulations or definitions or instructions in the nature of Rules and Regulations printed for convenience in other parts of this Schedule shall be deemed to form part of these Rules and Regulations.
 27. Should any question arise which is not provided for in these Regulations, the decision of the Committee shall be final, subject to appeal to the Kennel Club.
 28. The Committee of Working Breeds Association of Wales can accept no responsibility for products advertised or sold by standholders at this Show and exhibitors are reminded that grooming products on sale may not meet the requirements of the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for exhibition.
 29. The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club licensed events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car and caravan parks and approaches. This Regulation applies before (at any time during the set up period at the venue), during the event and afterwards (at any time during the breakdown of the event).
 30. A dog may be disqualified by the General Committee from any award, whether an objection has been lodged or not, if proved amongst other things to have been: a) registered or recorded as having been bred by the scheduled Judge, this shall not apply to a Judge appointed in an emergency; b) exhibited without payment of appropriate entry fees.
 31. Every exhibitor shall ensure that whilst the dog is being exhibited, its handler shall display the correct ring number.
-

• DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES •

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club.

Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.

In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.

In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. **Thursday, 1st March 2012**. A dog is not eligible for entry in Variety Classes (excluding AVNSC classes) unless also entered and subsequently exhibited in a Breed class where such a class is provided for which it is eligible. Exemptions from this Regulation are:

- (1) A puppy, unless a class for dogs under twelve months of age for which it is eligible is provided for the breed.
- (2) A dog in Any Variety Field Trial or Working Trial Class.
- (3) A dog in Any Variety Veteran Class.
- (4) A dog in Any Variety Champion Class.
- (5) A dog which is withdrawn from exhibition in breed classes as a result of the appointment of an emergency judge.
- (6) A dog in YKC Stakes Classes.
- (7) A dog in Good Citizen Scheme Classes.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:

(1) **Withdrawal**

The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) and 20.

(2) **Transfer**

- a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted, to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- b) If an exhibit is entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or twenty four calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling class to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

- MINOR PUPPY** For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.
- PUPPY** For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.
- JUNIOR** For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.
- YEARLING** For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four months of age on the first day of the Show.
- NOVICE** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First Prizes at Open and Championship shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).
- GRADUATE** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or 4 or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open Classes whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.
- POST GRADUATE** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or 5 or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open Classes whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.
- LIMIT** For dogs which have not become show Champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit and Open classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.
- OPEN** For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.
- VETERAN** For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.
- CHAMPION** For dogs which have been confirmed a Champion, Show Champion or Field Trial Champion.
- RARE BREEDS** Confined to those breeds not granted Challenge Certificates in the current year, with the exception of those breeds whose registration is confined to the Imported Register.
- IMPORTED REGISTER** When an Interim Breed Standard has been approved by the Kennel Club, breeds whose registration is confined to the Imported Register may be exhibited in this class only and are ineligible for any other competition whatsoever.
- AVNSC** For breeds of dog for which no separate breed classes are scheduled.
- YKC MEMBERS' STAKES** All pedigree dogs are eligible to take part provided the dog is registered on the Kennel Club Breed Register. The dog must be registered either a) solely or jointly in the member's name; or b) in the name of a member of the family and under these circumstances the dog must be resident at the YKC member's address. No substitute handlers are permitted - the dog must be handled by the YKC member. Members are not permitted to allow another individual to show their dog on their behalf if they are not able to attend the class. Members must be aged 6 - 24 years (for members 6 years and up to, but not including 25th birthday). Please note that membership of the YKC terminates on the member's 25th birthday. Therefore if a member is aged 25 years or over by the first day of Crufts they will be unable to compete. Please keep this in mind when entering qualifiers throughout the competing year.
- Crufts 2013 Qualification Procedure:** The first placed member only in each dog group at the qualifying show will qualify for Crufts. A rosette and prize money is awarded. If the first placed member has already qualified, the Crufts qualification will roll down to the next member (down to third place only).
- YKC MEMBERS' HANDLING CLASSES (For fully paid up members of the YKC only).** Exhibitors may handle any dog providing it is entered in a previous class at this show, fully registered on the Kennel Club Breed register, and eligible to be exhibited at Kennel Club licensed events. The 1st placed exhibitor from each Handling class will be invited to take part in the YKC members Handling Competition at Crufts 2013, provided when they qualify they are a fully paid up member of the YKC. For the purpose of these classes, handler's ages should be calculated as their age on the first day of the Show. Entries must be made on the entry form, no entries taken on the day.
- PUPPY STAKES** For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Dogs must also be entered in a breed class.
- JUNIOR STAKES** For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Dogs must also be entered in a breed class.
- KENNEL CLUB GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME STAKES** For dogs that have achieved their GCDS Bronze Award Certificate or above.

ADVISORY NOTICE

NOT FOR COMPETITION Societies may at their discretion, accept Not for Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed.

BREEDERS' COMPETITION

The Breeders' Competition offers the following Awards:

Best Breeder in Breed/AVNSC classes 1st, 2nd and 3rd

Best Breeder in Group 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th

Grand Final at Crufts 2013

The following requirements apply to entries for these awards:

1. Breeders wishing to enter the competition should first purchase a Breeders Competition Record Book from the Kennel Club or from the show secretary.
2. The Breeder enters for the award in his/her name and is responsible for arranging which exhibits form their breeder group, or team.
3. The Breeder must complete the Record Book accurately with all necessary details before presenting it to the show organisers.
4. The Breeder is responsible for obtaining the necessary authority to compete from the show organisers (or designated official such as the Ring Steward) to compete for the award.
5. The Breeder's team must consist of a minimum of three and a maximum of four dogs of the same breed, all of which must be entered in a class at the show.
6. A Breeder may enter more than one team per show.
7. All dogs must have the same registered breeder.
8. The 'beaten dog' rule will NOT apply.
9. Best Breeder in Breed and Best Breeder in AVNSC Classes goes through to a Best Breeder in Group award.
10. Breeders acquire points in competition over a calendar year as follows:

Best Breeder in Breed/AVNSC Classes	3 points
Second place Breeder in Breed/AVNSC Classes	2 points
Third place Breeder in Breed/AVNSC Classes	1 point
Best Breeder in Group	4 points
Second place Breeder in Group	3 points
Third place Breeder in Group	2 points
Fourth place Breeder in Group	1 point

The Breeders who have amassed a minimum of 25 points over a calendar year will qualify for the Final/Semi-Final in the following year. It is not a requirement to withdraw from the competition upon reaching 25 points. At the end of the competition year in question, Breeders should forward their record books to the Canine Activities Department at the Kennel Club which will advise whether they have qualified for the Crufts Final.
